

Malaysia-India Business Council Seminar

Following the eventful visit of Prime Minister Dato' Sri Najib Tun Razak to India, a large trade delegation comprising corporate business leaders from the land of Taj Mahal attended the Malaysia-India Business Council (MIBC) Seminar held in Kuala Lumpur recently.

The Seminar, jointly organised by the MIBC and Malaysian Associated Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (MAICCI), aimed at improving the bilateral relations between Malaysia and India. Over 500 delegates from both countries attended the one-day seminar themed, "Towards A Strategic Partnership – Tapping Growth Opportunities".

In his keynote address after launching the event, Dato' Sri Najib affirmed that during his visit to India in January this year, both

Malaysian and Indian private sectors were upbeat to do more. He also commended the MIBC for creating a platform for Malaysian and Indian businesses to interact through the Seminar.

On his part, the Union Commerce and Industry Minister of India, Mr. Anand Sharma, who led the trade delegation, sought greater Malaysian investments in building physical infrastructure and the participation of Malaysian sovereign investment funds.

Also present were International Trade and Industry (MITI) Minister, Datuk Seri Mustapha Mohamed, President of Malaysian Associated Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Datuk Kenneth Eswaran and MIBC President Datuk Krishnan Tan.
